Town Center Security

We recently experienced an incident at the Town Center where an unauthorized person, with the intent of removing property, was apprehended. In order to protect our residents, the Town Center will be locked each night at 5:30 PM, (unless there is a special event for that evening) and will re-open at 7:15 AM. Access during the lock-down time will require the use of your white swipe card. When the doors are in the locked position, please enter and exit through the doors with the locking mechanism, that is, the front Town Center doors or the kitchen entrance.

All Residents, especially event and activity chairs/co-chairs, are responsible for the security of the building at the end of the event. Make sure all doors to the outside are locked, even the ones to the pool. Also, anyone using a room with outside access is responsible for seeing that the door to the outside is locked (Omni Room to pool, for example). This is our park. Help keep it safe.

Process for Architectural requests:

- 1. Obtain form from website or Management Office
- 2. Fill out pertinent information
- 3. Submit to Manager, who will submit to Architectural Committee
- 4. Committee reviews, usually on Wednesdays, then sends back to manager with approval, denial
- 5. Manager issues permit
- 6. Owner / Resident posts permit upon start of work in a place viewable from the street.
- 7. Owner returns permit to Manager upon completion of work and then work is cleared from website.

A few landscape notes: if there is a transformer /distribution box on your lot (green box), you are responsible for any landscaping maintenance of your plants around the box. Any plants must be at least two feet away from box.

Southland Lakes Development and Luckett Road Expansion

- There has not been any activity regarding the commercial and industrial areas in the Southland Lakes development properties. (This is the undeveloped property on the south side of Luckett Rd.)This includes the connection of Forum Blvd.
- There is no funding listed in the Five Year plan for the Luckett Rd. project. This indicates that there will be no activity anticipated on Luckett Rd. until 2019.
